- 2. Motion to accept the September 11, 2018 General Meeting minutes was made by Ann King via email on September 12, 2018 Minutes approved
- 3. Principal's Update Mrs. Gallagher
- Why we choose butterflies for PBIS (read butterfly poem). Each child is special.
- "Social Emotional Learning in the Classroom" (book): all teachers, specialist, paras, secretary reading
- Raptor sign in was tested today and starting to use on Monday. Visitors need to sign out. Office will call people who don't sign out.
- ALICE training: Mrs. Gallagher, Mrs. Poxon, Mrs. Bellafonte, and Officer Sinko went to training in Sutton on PD Day
- Paintings in Sutton schools (i.e. Harry Potter, Mary Poppins) and their art teacher had a grant to do this. Officer Sinko finding out about the grant. Someone suggested high school students possibly doing.
- Speed bump in parking lot put in recently as part of safety committee suggestion (meet every Thursday morning at 8:00)
- Pick up; "ropes" makes parents come in and move around to the exit instead of lingering at entrance

- Has recess cart request list from teachers to go over with Kelly. She will send list then meet in person to discuss

- 4. SOAR and PBIS information sharing Mrs. Jessica Perry, Special Educator
- PBIS: **P**ositive **B**ehavior Intervention & **S**upports:
- Focuses on the development of pro-social behaviors (pre-k through 4th)
- Data driven
- Clough has 99% teacher buy in for PBIS

- Core staff: Clough has 20 staff members as their core staff
- Can take 3-5 years to implement; 3 tiers
 - Tier 1: this year; effective for about 80% of population
 - Tier 2; These kids may need extra support (i.e. lunch groups).
 - Tier 3: 5% of population may need individual behavior plans
- Students earn butterflies for positive behavior in all areas of school
 - Cafeteria lesson plan taught in October
 - Recess lesson plan taught in November
 - Bathroom lesson plan taught in December
- Tier 2 of PBIS will be rolled out during 2019-2020 school year
- SOAR (Safe, On-task, Act-KCR (kind, caring, respectful), Responsible)
- Voice Meter was introduced (level 0 through level 5)
- Introduction of School Wide Silent Sign ("5, 4, 3, 2, 1")

- Fundraising up about \$6k
