  - Cash for Clough statistics:

\* <u>2018/2019</u>: We had 14 different people donate \$1,662 (including through employer withdrawals and matches) plus \$650 from community donations (\$500 Harvard Pilgrim plus Middlesex Savings Bank) = \$2,312

\* <u>2019/2020</u>: We had 28 different people (17 new from last year) who have donated \$1,800 plus \$500 misc community donations (Planet Aid, American Girl, bake sale) = \$2,300

- 2020-2021: Open positions and opportunities to volunteer; Board positions to shadow
  \* The President position for the PTO board is open. Kelly will run for Vice President and train someone to be President. 3 board members will remain on board for transitioning so not new board (Myah Stone- Recording sec and Mike Kelley treasurer also staying)
  \* Mrs. Gallagher will need 2 student council reps.
  - \* Need 2 people to step up for golf.

- Craft Roots: They will donate the space to have a fundraiser in August, September, or October. Mrs. Gallagher suggesting having high school students babysit at the school.

- School kits (school supplies): Lyndsey provided an update. This year we have a new vendor-EPI. The sale will run from May 6th through June 14th. Kits should be in by July 27th. Kelly asked Lyndsey to touch base with Mr. Hanson for any kits he may need for students. Mrs. Gallagher asked if we could be at the kindergarten screening on May 7 with a sample box.
