- Box Tops collection/clippings Renee Wojdag
 - Renee reported that we hit our box tops goal already. We can mail our box tops directly to Renee. Monique will post and tell people to direct message us for Renee's address or they can mail to the school. Wendy suggested posting something to FB about how to earn credit for receipts online. Renee said she would come up with something for us to post.
- EPI School Supplies Lyndsey Nickerson
 - Final changes from teachers to be loaded then we will start advertising
 - EPI has agreed to hold items in the warehouse until school openings are confirmed and to push order end dates
 - PTO planned to buy bulk items (wipes, tissues, and hand sanitizer) in order to remove from individual kits and reduce costs to parents. However, current supply issue. Also, the district should be ensuring all cleaning supplies ready for students to be in the building. How do we support this? How do we get supplies?
 - Dr. M's town hall meeting indicated that the district will have the PPE, including masks
 - Lyndsey wants orders in by June 14th.
 - Lyndsey reported the plan is for the company to deliver supplies by July 7th. However, the company will hold our order until we are ready.
 - There's also the option of buying a cleaning kit for class which includes wipes, kleenex and hand sanitizer.
 - Beth asked if the company sold masks that we could add.
 - Lyndsey to get a flyer start posting to PTO page, class pages, PTO email etc. Add comment with option to buy a good neighbor kit
 - Lyndsey is waiting to hear from Evan Hanson on how many Good Neighbor kits to order
- 4th Grade Celebration Kelly Lomnicki, Meg Collins, Renee Wojdag, Jamie Fernades
 - Slideshow to be presented via Zoom and shared through youtube link at school year-end
 - Board voted to approve an additional \$800 as proposed by committee to purchase yard signs for all 4th graders. Mrs. Gallagher and 4th-grade teachers will deliver signs.

 - When is the right time to ask for sponsorships? Will Oasis still be willing to sponsor? Can our golfers alone carry us? Luncheon restrictions etc. Review past year sponsors to see who might be in a position to still support us.
 - Possibility of new chairs: Joe Casula, Ashley Grover, and Brandon Landers while shadowing Erick and Christine Brown in their last year
 - Committee: Meg Collins, Jen Talamini, Kelly Lucier
 - Need to set a more realistic budget
 - Kelly: Maybe we won't ask companies for sponsorship if we have it in September.
 - Kelly suggested still having the tournament to hold our place, as a placeholder but not as fundraiser. So this year still have x annual tournament and the following year would be x year. To keep the tradition going, with maybe only a few foursomes who are still willing and able to golf. But this might not be worth it to Shining Rock.
 - Christine: Maybe move the tournament to Spring?
 - Christine: Suggested asking Oasis to move their sponsorship to the Turkey Trot.
 - Meg: Suggested we spend our time trying to figure out various scenarios for the tournament. Kelly said the committee will have a meeting soon to do this.
 - Myah suggested we can still do the raffle but maybe as an online auction as part of the golf event (i.e. police car ride, fire truck ride). FYI - we had planned to take the silent auction part out of the golf tournament to open house so it's open to more people.
 - Christine brought up the fact that we may not want to be asking people for money during this time.
- Turkey Trot Thanksgiving

 - When is the right time to ask for sponsorships
 - Maybe we don't do as a fundraiser but continue with the event as community good faith...to ensure x Annual and keep the tradition going
 - Christine Quimby: Suggested a virtual run. Maybe more people would sign-up.
 - Kelly suggested still having the tournament to hold our place, as a placeholder. So this year still have 4th annual tournament and the following year would be 5th year. To keep the tradition going. Who knows if we can even have the get together.

- Fundraising may look different for next year..ideas for online fundraising?
 - Events such as family fun nights and CNO will likely not be realistic. Even if restrictions are lifted, we still need to support our community small businesses

* Meg: Suggested asking Liquor World for a sponsorship, virtual zoom event.

* Mike: Suggested having a celebrity come to a zoom event. - Bruins, Red Sox may donate to community.
